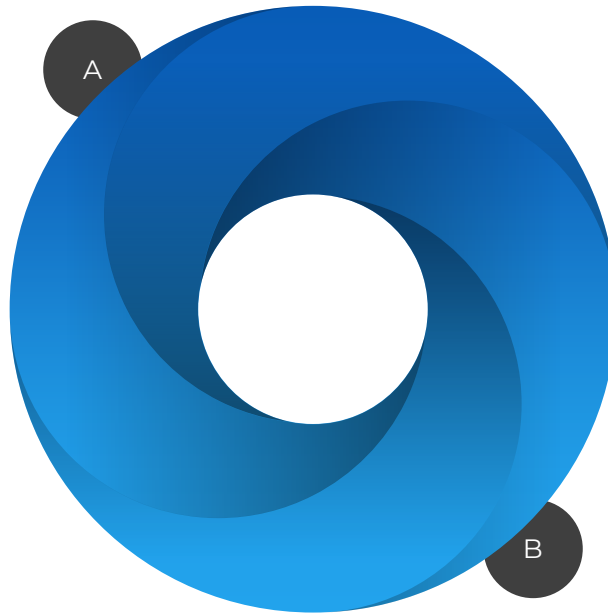
Provide a reliable and sustainable platform for research data and outputs

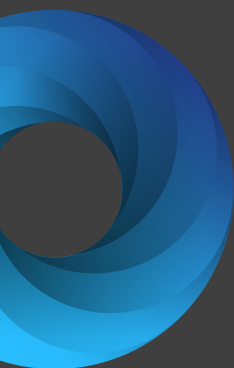

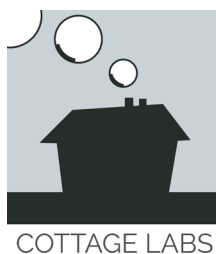

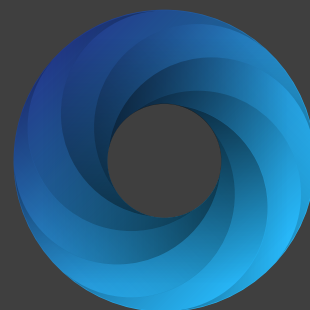


InvenioRDM - Open-Source software powering Zenodo
